## PORTFOLIO MANAGER

This is the job into which many CFA charterholders land after passing the exam. This job consists of making investing decisions using other peoples' money or financial institutions' assets.

## CHIEF EXECUTIVE

According to the CFA Institute, CEOs are 7 percent of CFA charterholders. Serving as the head of the company, outside of the boardroom, this is the top position and one that becomes obtainable with a CFA charter.

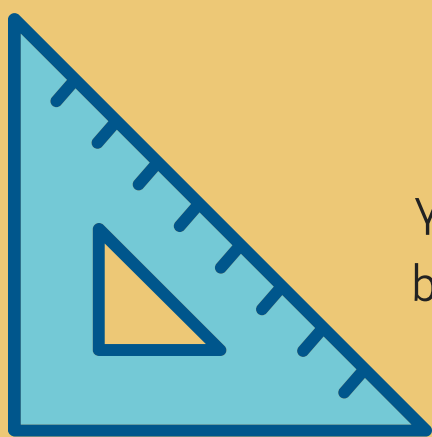
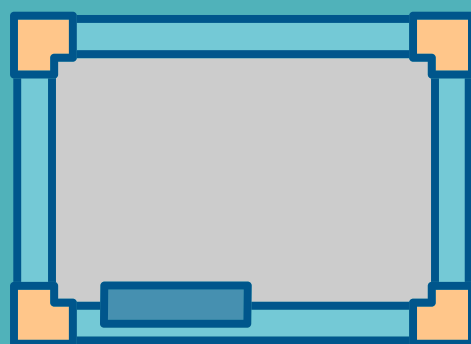


## RESEARCH ANALYST

This is one of the more interesting jobs available to CFA charterholders. Included among the usual duties are reviewing publicly traded companies, data collection, making recommendations on firms' securities, and influencing the markets.

## CONSULTANT

Once you have your CFA charter, you can work as a consultant to financial firms or in a money managing role for startups or individuals. Consultants are able to work for a larger firm or in an independent manner.



## CORPORATE FINANCIAL ANALYST

You're going to be supporting management decisions by providing thorough and actionable financial data to the process. You spend a lot of time developing projections and monitoring finances.

## RISK MANAGER

This one is pretty self explanatory: you use your financial acumen to steer your firm away from danger. This is a valuable role, especially within larger entities, and there's plenty of work given the current financial climate.
